Builders Club is the largest service organization for middle school and junior high school students in the world. Members work to develop servant-leader skills and while learning to work together as they serve their school and community. Community-based Builders Clubs, which are sponsored by Kiwanis, can also be established at churches, libraries, Boys & Girls Clubs, YMCAs, lodges or similar facilities.

Where are they?

The first Builders Club was chartered in 1975. There are currently 1,600 clubs that cumulatively have 45,000 members in 16 different countries. Like Circle K, their collegiate counterpart, they are broken down into districts.

- Vision: To develop competent, capable, caring leaders through the vehicle of service.
- Preferred Charities:
 - Children's Miracle Network: Builders Club participates with Children's Miracle Network by sponsoring fundraising events and participating in service projects at their local children's hospital.
 - March of Dimes: Builders Club partners with the March of Dimes to give every baby a healthy start by raising thousands of dollars annually through various programs, including its signature event, March for Babies.
 - UNICEF: Builders Clubs focus mainly on the Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF fundraiser to raise money for The Eliminate Project. The Global Campaign for Children will reach to some of the world's poorest and most underserved women and children—and help eliminate maternal and neonatal tetanus from the planet.
