

CKI DUES STRUCTURE

All CKI clubs are expected to pay annual dues to the International and District between October 1st and December 1st each year. Dues can be paid by club officers or advisors through the Membership Update Center.

International Dues Structure:

Below are the International dues for the 2024/25 administrative year. These dues, which support the services provided to members, vary by country and are based on the per capita income of the country where the CKI club is located. Additional detail on CKI dues and tiers are available in the CKI bylaws.

Tiers	2024/25 International Dues
Clubs in Tier A nations	US\$32 per member
Clubs in Tier B nations	US\$13 per member
Clubs in Tier C nations	US\$7 per member

District Dues Structure:

District dues are set by a District's House of Delegates and approved by their Kiwanis District Board and the CKI International Board. District dues cover the operations of the District Board and the district budget. A full list of district dues can be found on the <u>CKI website</u>.

Important Deadlines:

Date	Deadline
October 1	Dues payment begins.
November 1	Early dues deadline.*
December 1	Dues deadline.
February 1	The status of unpaid clubs changes to "suspended."
September 30	The status of unpaid (suspended) clubs changes to "inactive."^

^{*} Clubs that submit their dues and rosters prior to November 1 each year will be eligible for recognition and the chance to win prizes.

Fees for New Charters:

There is no additional fee for a newly chartered CKI club. New clubs will pay the per-member international dues for every member on their roster along with their district dues, if applicable. To be chartered, the clubs must have the minimum number of members per club as described in CKI's bylaw and policy documents.

Newly chartered clubs will receive a welcome kit that includes a letter from the CKI director, stickers, a charter certificate, a recruitment brochure packet, recruitment posters, and links

to training videos and other materials. Clubs wishing to purchase banners, bells, gavels, member pins and other materials may do so separately at the <u>Kiwanis store</u>.

Reactivation Fee Structure:

A club that has not paid their international fees by the deadlines listed above will be listed as "Inactive." Inactive clubs will need to pay a \$24* reactivation fee, District dues, and the International dues for their club and submit a petition of reactivation in order to become a club in good standing.
